Must be highly qualified and possess a valid Indiana teaching license for the grade level and/or subject assigned:

- Mild Intervention covering appropriate grades.
- Intense Intervention covering appropriate grades.

Will serve as Teacher of record and must follow all laws in accordance with the District's Special Education Procedures Manual and Article 7.

- Lead case conference committee meetings as students' teacher of record to assist in developing measurable goals, benchmarks, and objectives to meet student needs. Also to write appropriate BIP and FBA.
- Regularly monitor the implementation of the student's IEP and provide progress reports to the student's parents.
- Ensures student's IEPs are available to the appropriate teachers and service providers who are responsible for the implementation of the IEP.
- Ensures all supplementary aids, services, program modifications and supports for school personnel are provided in accordance with each student's IEP.
- Ensures any accommodations on statewide or district assessments are implemented according to the student's IEP.
- Monitors, assists, corrects, re-teaches and remediated student performance to ensure student progress;
